It will be a unique opportunity for all to share their experience and learn.

We look forward to your whole hearted support and involvement to make this event successful, meaningful, and memorable.

Objective of the Convention

This will be a forum for interaction and sharing of knowledge and ideas on

- Quality Circles by QC members
- Allied concepts such as Lean Quality Circles, TPM, 5-S, Six Sigma, Kaizen, SMED, SGA, WCM, etc. by Officers, Executives and Associates, Cross Functional Teams, etc.
- ➤ To learn and understand practical aspects of Quality Concept better.
- ➤ To provide an opportunity to bring out creativity in its best form through Posters, Presentations and Visual displays.
- > To provide 'Recognition' and 'Encouragement' to participants.

This Convention is to help teams for participating in the National Convention to be held at Mysuru during December 2017

Who Should Attend?

- ➤ Organizations where Quality Circle and Allied projects on Lean Quality Circles, Sigma, TPM,5-S, SIx sigma, Kaizen, SMED, SGA, WCM, etc. are being practiced.
- > Organization about to launch Quality Circle and other Allied Concepts.
- Organization and Individuals participating in Quality Circle and desirous to know about other Allied Concepts
- **Educational Institutions**

➤ Kaizen Display (Visual Presentation)

- ➤ Problems solved through Kaizen concept can be displayed during the Convention. Separate hall will be dedicated. Each team consists of **THREE** members. Every team is required to present **THREE** Kaizens. Teams submitting less than **THREE** Kaizens will lose marks. When a team submits more than **THREE** Kaizens, the team should choose any **THREE** for evaluation purposes. Display space is provided for only **THREE** Kaizens on A3 sheets which are submitted for evaluation. The kaizen meant for display should be submitted in A4 size paper (in **Form 31** to QCFI, Mysuru Chapter **on or before 09 th May 2017.**
- ➤ A panel of jury members visits the display area for evaluation (maximum of 10 minutes per team) and Prizes will be awarded. The Kaizen Display is restricted to State level conventions only.

Demonstration of Innovative Models (for Students only)

This is a new concept to bring out the ingenuity of students. Innovative and artistic ideas converted into practical reality can be displayed through working models and charts. A team of **TWO** students per project is permitted from each Institution. Separate hall will be dedicated for display.

A panel of Jury members will visit the display area for evaluation (maximum of 10 minutes per team) and Prizes will be awarded.

Knowledge Test (Optional)

Knowledge test is conducted for Quality Circle and Lean Quality Circle teams. It is advisable to participate in the knowledge test, as it is mandatory in NCQC. This is an open book competition. Duration of the knowledge test is **TWENTY** minutes. Facilitators are not allowed. **Prizes will be awarded to the winners. Use** of Mobile **phones/laptops is strictly prohibited.**

Poster / Slogan Competition - Theme: Productivity / Quality / Safety

To encourage the creativity among the Quality Circle members/Allied teams and Students, poster and slogan competitions are being organized. Poster / Slogan should be drawn on A2 size (420 mm X 594 mm) art paper. These should be original and not have been presented elsewhere. They can be either in Kannada or in English. Only one Poster/Slogan per person is permitted. Prizes will be awarded to the Winners.

Essay Competition

Theme: Enhancing Human Resources Performance

The essay should be hand written and not exceeding **400 words** and in A4 size paper only. It may be either in Kannada or in English. One essay per person is permitted. **Prizes will be awarded to the winners.**

In Poster/Slogan/Essay Competitions, entry should have the name of the participant and name of the team Category which he/she represents, along with the Name of the Organization.

There is NO ENTRY FEE for Poster/Slogan/Essay Competitions. Last date for submission of all entries is 9 th May 2016 and they should be sent to QCFI, Mysuru Chapter, Mysuru.

Selected entries will be given Certificates and those who are attending the Convention will also be given a memento.

Recognition

Based on the evaluation, the participating teams will be given awards along with participation certificates .

> 70% and above GOLD

➤ 60% and above, but less than 70% SILVER

> 50% and above, but less than 60% BRONZE

The teams who score below 50% gets **Participation Certificates** only.

Nominations along with **ONE** hard copy of the case study material and related soft copy in **CD** media MS office 2007 version and QC record book (only for QC Teams) for Evaluation -should reach the Bengaluru Chapter office on or before

Guidelines and General Information for participation in the Competition:

- > Only Institutional Members of QCFI are eligible to nominate teams.
- Non -members of QCFI should become Institutional Members before nominating their teams. Membership forms can be obtained from Hon. Secretary, QCFI, Mysuru chapter or from Hon. Secretary, QCFI, Hyderabad, or downloading from web site www.qcfiblr.in. General theories on quality concepts are to be avoided in the presentation
- The presentation need to be within the prescribed time limit of **Fifteen** Minutes. After the presentation, questions will be asked for **Five** minutes by Jury only. Facilitators are not allowed to answer questions.
- There will not be any registration after **22-05-2017**. However, as a special case the teams submitting the case studies after 22-05-2017 can participate in the presentations and the results will be announced after a period of two weeks, after the Convention.
