### III. 1st Knowledge Test for QC Team Members

Knowledge test is not compulsory for Chapter Convention but is mandatory for NCQC-2017. Therefore test will be conducted, but will not carry any marks for inclusion in the case study evaluation. However, these marks will be considered for selection of the teams for the Quiz competition. The question paper will be given during registration. The same, duly answered, to be submitted by 11.00 a.m on 21st September 2017.

### IV. Essay/Poster/Poem/Slogan Competitions

To encourage the creativity in Quality Circle members, Poster, Poem and Slogan competitions shall be organised on the spot. Essay on the theme of the Convention may be submitted with the case studies i.e before 01.09.2017. Only registered delegates are eligible.

#### V. Model Exhibition

There will be a model exhibition at the venue. Best models will be suitably awarded. Teams are required to display their QC name and organisation. The criteria for evaluation on relevance to the project presented, creativity, use of scrap, skill of explaining, moving/ live model.

### VI. Quiz Contest

A Quiz competition will be conducted for QC teams. Six teams for quiz competition will be selected on the basis of the score in 2<sup>nd</sup> level knowledge test conducted on 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2017.

### VII. Cultural Programme

Cultural programme will be organised on 22<sup>nd</sup> Sept' 2017, where in, different events like skits, songs, dances etc. will be performed by the participants. Interested members are requested to give their consent before hand so that necessary arrangements can be made.
