III. Knowledge Test For QC Team Members

Knowledge Test is not mandatory for Chapter Convention. Test score will not be considered for the case study evaluation in the Chapter Convention but the same will be considered to shortlist the teams for Quiz competition. The question paper will be given during registration. The same, duly answered, to be submitted before lunch on 16th October, 2016.

IV. Forum for facilitators and Co-ordinators

Executives, Managers, Co-ordinators and Facilitators who attend the convention will deliberate on convention theme.

V. Model Exhibition

Teams are required to display their QC name and organization at the Model Exhibition. The criteria for evaluation will be on relevance to the project presented, creativity, use of scrap, skill of explaining, moving/live model. Judges will visit the Exhibition on 16th October, 2016 at 11 AM to evaluate and select the best model.

VI. Quiz Contest

Three QC teams for quiz contest will be selected on the basis of knowledge test score.

VII. Valedictory Session

All case studies and technical papers and registration forms duly filled and signed along with organization profile + Registration Fee for participating QC members should reach the convention Secretariat before 05^{th} October, 2016 along with meeting register.
