The Silver Jubilee Convention is scheduled to be held on 10th and 11th of September 2016 at Anand Institute of Higher Technology, Kalasalingam Nagar, IT Corridor, Old Mahabalipuram Road, Kazhipathur, Chennai - 603 103. The convention will feature case study presentations and competitions like poem writing, slogan writing, quiz, poster, debate and Kaizen.

- To offer the participants an opportunity to share and exchange their experiences and best practices.
- To make the QC movement self generating and an ever growing segment of Total Quality Management
- To encourage the spirit of competition, team work and continuous improvement.

CONVENTION EVENTS

Quality Circle case study presentation

Case studies by QC teams from Manufacturing Industries, Service Organisations, Banks, Hospitals and IT industries will be presented in the Convention. Case studies will be presented only by the members of the QCs. Presentation will be evaluated by a panel of Judges. **Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals** will be awarded to the case study presentations based on the marks scored by the teams. There is no restriction on the number of QC teams from the same organisation to participate in the case study presentations.

Prize winning circles will be recommended to participate in the National Convention to be held at RAIPUR from 16th to 18th, December 2016.

Quiz

Quiz Will be conducted to assess the knowledge of participants in problem solving, usage of QC tools and other QC concepts.

Poster / Slogan / Poem Competitions

The above competitions will provide an opportunity to the QC members to exhibit their creative talent.

Debate

Debate will bring out the oratorical skill and knowledge on QC concepts of the participants. This will be conducted in Tamil.

Kaizen Competition

This event will provide a platform to share the improvements made and implemented by the individuals in respect of productivity, quality, cost, delivery, systems etc.

5SAward

This event will be held one / two weeks before the convention. Participation fee for this competition is ₹ 18,000/- + 15% ST for the award.

Industries and Institutions can participate in the competition. On - site inspection will be conducted by a panel of experts. Based on the score, industries will be rated and awarded. Report on areas for improvement will be given to the individual organisations. For further details please contact QCFI Chennai Chapter Office.

Important Points:

- ♦ Vegetarian Food will be served in the convention. Please inform the participants.
- ♦ No knowledge test in CCQCC, but will be conducted in NCQC 2016. This carries 40 marks.
- ♦ QC Register marks will be included in CCQCC 2016. Hence QC Register, hard copy of case study presentation must be handed over on 10.09.2016 at the Registration Counter.
- 10 Steps problem solving method will be followed in CCQCC where as 12 steps method is followed in NCQC.
- For NCQC, Co-ordinators of the company have to send the hard and soft copy of QC case study to HQ directly.
