NOTE:

- 1. For the above competitions, participation Registration Forms 1 & 2 should be submitted without fail.
- 2. The Organizations / Institutions which desire to participate in the demonstration of Innovative models have to send a brief write up about the display, to QCFI. If a power supply is required, an advance intimation has to be sent to QCFI.
- 3. Teams winning GOLD awards in QC and Allied Teams are only eligible to participate in NCQC 2016 to be held at Raipur.
- 4. Teams participating under Kaizan Display and Demonstration of Innovative Models are not eigible to participate in NCQC 2016.

KNOWLEDGE TEST (OPTIONAL)

Knowledge Test will be conducted for all Teams Except Kaizen display Teams. Facilitators are allowed to participate. This is an open book competition. Duration of the test is 20 minutes. Use of mobile phone and laptop during knowledge test is strictly prohibited.

POSTER AND SLOGAN COMPETITION:

Topic: Quality, Productivity and Safety

The poster and slogan should be drawn on A3 Size drawing sheet, leaving margin of 3cms on all four sides. They can be prepared in English, Kannada or Hindi. Posters and Slogans are restricted to ONE per person, in each category. Only Team Members who are participating in the convention are eligible. Prizes will be awarded to winners in each category.

ESSAY COMPETITION:

Topic: People's Participation & Passion-the Path way to overall Success

Essay should not exceed 400 words. It should be legibly handwritten in A4 size white paper, leaving a margin of 2cm on all the four sides. They can be either in English, Kannada or Hindi. Only Team Members who are participating in the Convention are eligible. Prizes will be awarded to winners in each category.

In these three cases, entry should have the name of the Participant and Team which he / she represents, along with name of the organisation.

There is no ENTRY FEE for all the above THREE competitions. For Poster, Slogan and Essay Competitions, the last date for submission is 17th August 2016.

- * Only Institutional Members of QCFI are eligible for Quality Circle / Allied Quality Concepts case study presentations and Kaizen Display.
- * However, non-members (Institutional) of QCFI may also nominate teams for competitive presentations provided they enroll as Members immediately by submitting membership applications obtainable from QCFI office or by downloading from QCFI Website www.qcfiblr.in, along with the membership fee.
- * Teams from outside the Region / Chapter may also participate.
- * All participating QC teams have to **mandatorily submit** their QC Record Book for evaluation Marks awarded for this record book will be considered for the overall marks at CCQC-2016.
- * Maximum of 15 minutes is permitted for case study presentation during the convention and 5 minutes for answering the Judge's questions only.
- * The Case Studies should pertain to improvements made between 1st August 2015 and 31st July 2016. Case studies already presented at Regional or Chapter or National Conventions are not eligible.
- * Front page of the case study shall have the following details:
 - Name of the Organization
 - Name of the Team
 - Title of the Case Study
 - Category of Case Study (QC, 5-S, Six Sigma, etc)
- * Non-members (Institutional or individuals) can participate as DELEGATES only.

 There will not be any registration of case studies after 3rd Sept 2016. However as a special case, the teams submitting the case studies after 3rd Sept 2016 can participate in the presentation by paying the late fee along with the registration fees, but the results will be announced after a minimum of two weeks, from the date of convention.
- * Registration fee shall be paid by Cheque / Demand Draft drawn in favour of "Quality Circle Forum of India, Bengaluru Chapter" payable at Bengaluru along with Registration Form No. 1 & 2.
