Knowledge Test for QC Team Members

Knowledge test is mandatory for the teams who wish to participate later in NCQC-2016. However, these marks will be considered for selection of the teams for Quiz competition. The question paper will be given during the time of registration. The team members shall appear for the test and duly answered sheets to be submitted by 11.00 a.m. on 13th September 2016. However, the marks in knowledge Test will not carry any weightage for the case study evaluation in CCQC.

It is an opportunity to the Executives, Managers, Coordinators & Facilitators to share their knowledge, learn from innovative project ideas and effectively network with other participants from different organisations.

Essay/Poster/Poem/Slogan Competitions

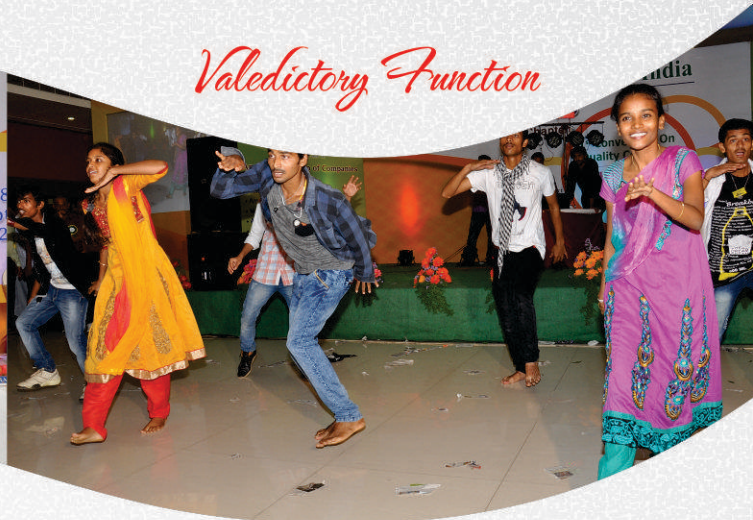
