While in India, Quality Circles concept started in 1982, for portraying the problem solving techniques LQC methodology was introduced in 2010.

The lean concept makes us think of such cases where we are not utilizing the potential of the people, who have developed themselves to solve the problems.

2. To give additional inputs of knowledge through education and training and put them on Lean manufacturing projects.
