About the Venue

AURO University, formerly AURO University of Hospitality and Management, is a private university located at Surat, Gujarat, India. It was established in 2011 through The Gujarat Private Universities (Amendment) Act, 2011.

The university was founded by H.P. Rama, a co-founder of JHM Hotels, which was a US-based hospitality company with operations in USA and India. The Auro name is also used for a hospitality business from 2017, when JHM was split between its founders (with their respective successors) into four companies: Auro Hotels, Siddhi Hotel Group, Sima Hotels, and Sarona Holdings.

Surat, the original Gateway of India, has been a host of many travelers and traders from different civilizations for centuries. Surat, the commercial capital of Gujarat, is one of the fastest growing cities in India. By 2020, it is estimated that Surat will be the largest city in Gujarat. Also, it is the textile capital of India and the diamond manufacturing capital of the world. Surat is widely regarded as one of the cleanest Metropolitan Regions in India.

Transport and Connectivity

Surat is connected to the national railway system through the Western Railways connecting it to Mumbai and beyond to the south as well as New Delhi, Ahmedabad, Vadodara and other cities to the north. Also, the city is connected to the national highway 8 through a 16 km connector highway. National Highway 8 corridor is one of the most industrially developed areas in the country and Surat. Surat is connected to Delhi, Mumbai, Hyderabad, Kolkata& Jaipur by air and to all the major cities of Gujarat.


