

Quality Circle Forum of India, Chennai Chapter 28th Convention, CCQCC - 2019

Focus

Chennai Chapter has been organizing QC Convention every year to encourage QC teams to share their achievements and for awarding the best project presentations. The 28th Convention is scheduled to be held on 7th and 8th of September 2019 at Sathyabama Institute of Science and Technology, Jeppiaar Nagar, Rajiv Gandhi Salai, Chennai - 600 119. The convention will feature case study presentations and competitions like poem writing, slogan writing, quiz, poster, debate, knowledge test and allied QC concepts.

Objectives

- To offer the participants an opportunity to share and exchange their experiences and best practices.
- To make the QC movement self-generating and an ever-growing segment of Total Quality Management.
- To encourage the spirit of competition, team work and continuous improvement.

Beneficiaries

- Existing Quality Circle members.
- Establishments desirous of starting Quality Circles.
- Organisations striving to keep pace with changing global scenario.
- Organisations aiming for world class quality.

Important Points

- Participants are informed that only vegetarian food will be served in the convention.
- Knowledge test will be conducted in CCQCC 2019 for 10 marks and the same will be added to QC Case study evaluation marks.
- QC Record marks will be included in CCQCC 2019. Hence QC Record book, hard copy of case study presentation must be handed over on 07.09.2019 at the Registration Counter in the Venue.
- 10-step problem solving method will be followed in CCQCC whereas 12-step method will be followed in NCQC.
- For NCQC, co-ordinators of the companies should send the hard and soft copies of the QC case study to HQ directly.

Convention Events Quality Circle Case Study Presentation

Case studies by QC teams from Manufacturing Industries, Service Organisations, Banks, Hospitals and IT industries will be presented in the Convention. Case studies will be presented only by the members of the QCs. Presentation will be evaluated by a panel of judges. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the case study presentations based on the marks scored by

the teams. There is no restriction on the number of QC teams from the same organisation to participate in the case study presentations.



Prize winning circles will be recommended to participate in the National Convention to be held at IIT (BHU) Varanashi from 27th to 30th December 2019.

Submit the following in a separate cover at the Registration Counter (on 07.09.2019 forenoon)

- a) One hard copy of Case Study.
- b) Record Book of the Quality Circle.
- Oral Presentation will be for a duration of 15 minutes followed by Q & A session for 5 minutes.
- Computer & LCD Projector will be provided at the venue.
 (To avoid compatibility issues, teams are recommended to bring their laptop)
- Only the members of QC teams registered for the convention can present their case study.

Quiz

Quiz will be conducted to assess the knowledge of participants in problem solving, usage of QC tools and other QC concepts.

- Two members per team (One Team per Registered QC Circle).
- Open to registered QC members only.
- Preliminary rounds will be conducted on 07.09.2019 forenoon.
- Final round will be conducted on 08.09.2019 afternoon.

Poster

The above competitions will provide an opportunity to the QC members to exhibit their creative talent.

- Theme will be given on the spot. Only one member per registered QC Circle.
- Drawing sheets, pencil and eraser will be given.
- Colouring materials to be brought by the participants.
- Event will be conducted on 07.09.2019 afternoon.

Slogan and Poem Competitions

The above competitions will provide an opportunity to the QC members to exhibit their creative talent.

- Theme will be given on the spot. Only one member per Registered QC Circle can participate.
- Drawing sheets, pencil and eraser will be given.
- Colouring materials to be brought by the participants
- Event will be conducted on 07.09.19 afternoon.

Debate

Debate will bring out the oratorical skill and knowledge on QC concepts of the participants. This will be conducted in Tamil / English

- One team per Registered QC Circle. Two participants per registered can participate team.
- (Delegates / Facilitators are not eligible).
- One member to talk for the topic and the other member to talk against the topic.
- 5 minutes duration per member and total 10 minutes per team.
- Event will be conducted on 07.09.2019

Knowledge Test

In order to prepare the QC teams for NCQC 2019 knowledge test (KT) has been introduced in chapter convention CCQCC 2019. It carries 10 marks and the team has to do jointly.

5 S Competition

This event will be held one / two weeks before the convention. Participation fee for this competition is ₹ 20,000 + 18% GST. DD / at par Cheque may be drawn in favour of QCFICC payable at Chennai.

Industries and Institutions can participate in the competition. On-site inspection will be conducted by a panel of experts. Based on the score, industries / institutions will be graded and awarded. Report on areas for improvement will be given to the individual organisations. The organisation interested to participate in the event need to register on or before 10th August, 2019. 
