




Venue - Trident-Academy of Technology, Bhubaneswar

Knowledge Test

Following the concept of NCQC, Knowledge Test is mandatory for all teams. The duration of test will be 20 minutes which will carry 50 marks in the result. Three members from QC Teams and Two Member from Allied Concept can participate in the Knowledge Test. There shall be separate papers for team members and average marks of team will be calculated for final evaluation. Facilitator may also take participate in Knowledge Test.


