

Focus

Chennai Chapter has been organizing QC Convention every year to encourage QC teams to share their achievements and for awarding the best project presentations. The 30th Convention is scheduled to be held on 22nd to 24th October 2021 through online mode in order to maintain the social distance. The convention will feature case study presentations and competitions like slogan writing, poster, and allied QC concepts.

Objectives

- To offer the participants an opportunity to share and exchange their experiences and best practices.
- To make the QC movement self-generating and an ever-growing segment of Total Quality Management.
- To encourage the spirit of competition, team work and continuous improvement.

Beneficiaries

- Existing Quality Circle members.
- Establishments desirous of starting Quality Circles.
- Organisations striving to keep pace with changing global scenario.
- Organisations aiming for world class quality.

Important Points

- The teams can register with QCFICC by mentioning the team name and organisation. Each team can have six members (including facilitator).
- The participating team should virtually present on a designated date and present the case study through online mode using Power Point presentation. Date of presentation and the online platform will be allotted on first come first basis
- On receiving the registration. the QCFICC will give you the time schedule to present the case study.
- The duration of presentation will be 20 minutes:15 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for Q&A.
- The organizations can choose their own online platform and inform the meeting link well in advance to QCFICC for the juries to be connected and to evaluate the project.
- 12-step problem solving method will be followed in CCQCC 2021
- The Certificate & Trophy will be sent through courier.

Quality Circle Case Study Presentation

Case studies by QC teams from Manufacturing Industries, Service Organisations, Banks, Hospitals and IT industries will be presented in the Convention. Case studies will be presented only by the organisational members of QCFI. Presentation will be evaluated by a panel of judges. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the case study presentations based on the marks scored by the teams. There is no restriction on the number of QC teams from the same organisation to participate in the case study presentations.

Chennai Chapter will be recommended to participate in the National Convention 2021.

Poster and Slogan Competitions

The above competitions will provide an opportunity to the QC members to exhibit their creative talent.

- Theme will be given on the spot. Only one member per registered QC Circle.
- Event will be conducted on 24th Oct 2021 afternoon through online mode.

Allied other QC concepts - Six Sigma and Lean QC

In order to have more knowledge, Competitions on allied concepts are also conducted through online mode
