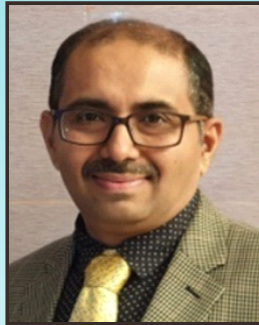

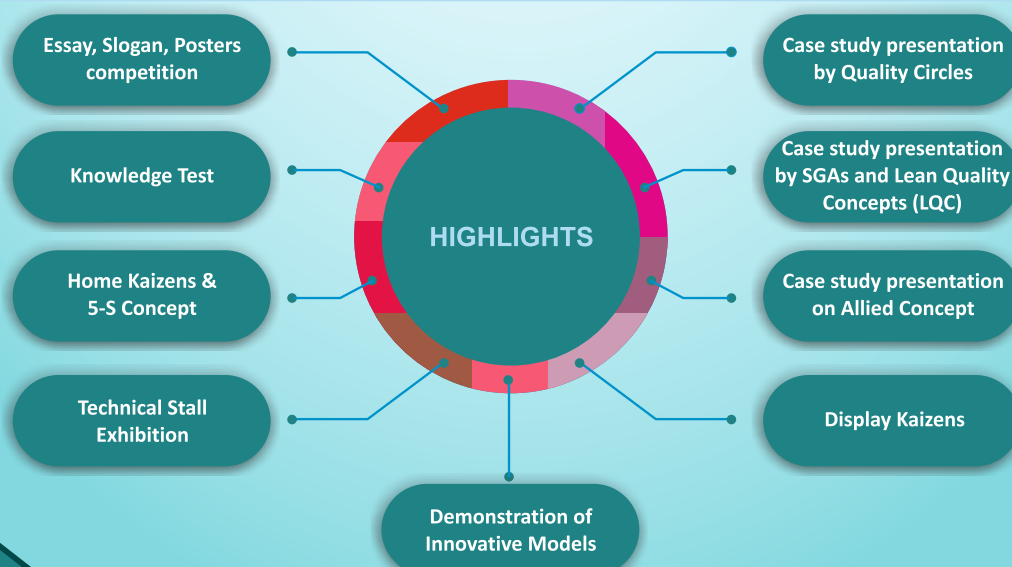

### VALUE ADDED ATTRACTIONS IN THE CONVENTION

**KNOWLEDGE TEST (Optional):** A test for each team, irrespective of the stream, about the philosophy of quality concepts and basic knowledge about QC tools & techniques of problem-solving approach.

**All the teams QC, LQC, LSC, Allied concepts.**

Duration: 20 min / 20 Questions.

Use of Mobile phone, Laptop during the Knowledge Test is strictly prohibited.

Facilitators are permitted along with Members.

### ESSAY (Theme: “Integrated Quality Concepts - The Gateway to Global Leadership”)

- Essays must be on the Theme only. It should be in either Kannada or Hindi or English and should not exceed 400 words. It should be legible, hand-written, and in A4 size white paper with a margin of 2cms.
- Only team members who participate in the convention are eligible. One essay in each language is allowed per person. Prizes will be awarded to Winners.

### SLOGAN & POSTER (Theme: “Integrated Quality Concepts - The Gateway to Global Leadership”)

- Eligibility: Should be a member of a team participating in the convention.
- Should be in A3 size with 3 cm margin on all the 4 sides.
- Kannada or Hindi or English.
- Legible and hand-written.
- Only one slogan/poster in each of the Languages will be allowed per person.
- Best slogan/poster will be awarded.

**No Registration fee for the ESSAY, SLOGAN, POSTER Competitions.  
Last Date for submission: 10th August 2022.**

## DISPLAY OF KAIZENS:

Two members can participate in display of Kaizen a team shall present 1 Kaizen only. This is mainly to bring out the creative talent of individuals. It can be explained in Model or in the Poster of A-3 size format given by QCFI in Form No. 3. Each team shall send the copies of the 1 Kaizen in A-4 format for pre-evaluation (50marks). Kaizen displayed will be assessed for 50 marks by the panel of Juries visiting the spot. Maximum time allowed for presentation / explanation is 10 minutes only. Kaizen will be awarded as per the same criteria.

## MODEL DEMONSTRATION:

Two members can participate in a team to demonstrate the Model display and explain to the Judges during their visit for evaluation. Best models will be awarded.

## PRODUCT EXHIBITION

- It gives an immense opportunity to technocrats, end users and participants of the Convention, who visit the stalls to have interaction and to know the latest developments that are taking place in manufacturing and service sectors.
- The Exhibition will cover all fields like Manufacturing, Steel, Cement, Textiles, Fertilizers, Power Engineering, Confectionery, Mechanical, Electrical, Electronics, Instrumentation, Garment industries, Food & Beverage Products.
- The Exhibitors are provided 3 mtrs x 3 mtrs space at the venue with a provision of display table, illumination facility and infrastructure.
- Stall allotment will be strictly done on first cum first basis. QCFI solicits wide response from various sectors of industry, including service sectors, to utilize the opportunity at CCQC 2022, where we expect around 2000 delegates and guests for the Convention.
- Delegates are required to drop their business card in the drop box in each stall. Lucky winners from each stall will be declared before Valedictory session.

## KAIZENS and 5S CONCEPT BY HOME MAKERS

In order to encourage Kaizen / 5S practices at home, QCFI wishes to encourage / recognize home makers at CCQC 2022, who have done improvements in their homes, to exhibit with the help of Model or Poster or presentation by PPT. PARTICIPATION IS FREE. Best teams will be awarded. Participating teams will have to register their names by sending a mail to QCFI on or before 31st July 2022.

## RULES FOR PARTICIPATION IN CONVENTION

- Institutional/Organization members Of QCFI are eligible to participate in Presentation/Display.
- Non-members of QCFI may also participate by enrolling as member immediately by submitting Membership Application obtainable from QCFI/downloading from QCFI website [www.qcfiblr.in](http://www.qcfiblr.in) along with membership fee.
- Teams from outside Region/Chapter may also participate. Any number of teams can be nominated.
- All QC teams have to mandatorily submit their QC Record Book for evaluation. Marks obtained QC Record Book is considered for awards in CCQC 2022.
- QC Register to be submitted by the teams at the registration counter (for evaluation) on the convention day before 9.00 AM and obtain the acknowledgement of the receipt, and collect the same at the trophy distribution counter on the same day after 2.00 PM by returning the acknowledgement receipt. If the QC Register not taken back the teams are only responsible to collect the same from QCFI Office after the convention at the earliest.
- Max. 15 minutes are allowed for presentation / display.
- The case studies should pertain to the period June 2021 May 2022. The case studies already presented at Regional/National Convention will be disqualified.
- Front page of case study should have the following details:
  - Name of Organization.
  - Name of team.
  - Title Of Case Study.
  - Category (viz. QC, Kaizen, 5-S, Six-sigma etc.)

- ❖ Non-members (Institutional / Individual) can participate as DELEGATES only.
- ❖ There will not be registration for presentation/display/demonstration after 20th August 2022. Spot Registration not available.
- ❖ However, spot registration is allowed only for Delegates by making the payment suitably at the registration counter at convention.
- ❖ Registration fee can be paid by Cheque/DD drawn in favour of **QUALITY CIRCLE FORUM OF INDIA, BENGALURU CHAPTER, payable at Bengaluru.**
