01 CASE STUDY PRESENTATION ON QUALITY CONCEPTS 3.



Chapter recommended Case Studies in chapter conventions are allowed to participate in National Convention and these case studies will be scheduled for presentation in parallel sessions at the NCQC.

The official language for presentation will be Hindi or English. For presentations in other languages, the teams are requested to arrange for their own translators.

Teams should have their own power point presentation either in Hindi or English. The entire presentation, including translation, need to be completed within the stipulated time limit of 15 minutes. Presentation of allied concepts will be conducted in separate halls and there would be separate evaluation criteria for each concept.

Note: Teams / Circles must upload detailed case study through online in PDF format for pre-evaluation evaluated for 100 marks. Last Date to upload is 15th November2022. The size of the Case study in PDF should be below 25 MB.

02 KNOWLEDGE TEST

Knowledge Test is compulsory for all the teams, it will be held on 21st, 22nd, & 23rd December 2022. Separate questions papers on QC, 5S, LQC, Allied concepts will be given based on the team circle type selection during registration. 3 Members/team to be selected to take the online test and average marks of the all 3 members will be taken for team's KT marks. Duration of the test is 20 minutes.



03 MODEL EXHIBITION

Model exhibition will be organized for the following:

Those team who are presenting their case study and bring their model for the demonstration may be allowed to participate in models competition for 3 Hrs on the same day of their case study presentation or on 27th Dec'22 i.e. on Inaugural day from 2.30 PM to 5.30 PM. First 100 entries will be allowed free and 25 models will be awarded.
