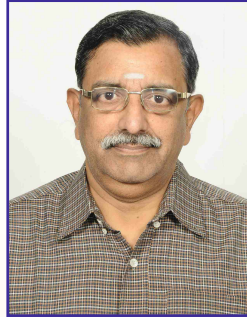

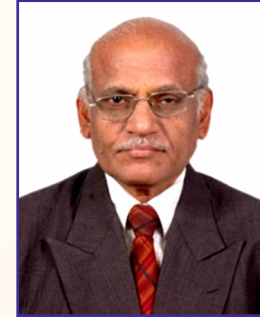

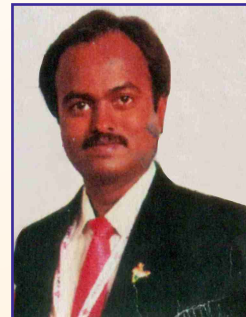

CCQCC - 2023

Focus

Chennai Chapter has been organizing QC Convention every year to encourage QC teams to share their achievements and for awarding the best project presentations. The 32nd Convention is scheduled to be held on **9th and 10th of September 2023 at Sathyabama Institute of Science and Technology, Jeppiaar Nagar, Rajiv Gandhi Salai, Chennai - 600 119**. The convention will feature case study presentations and competitions like poem writing, slogan writing, quiz, poster, debate, knowledge test and allied QC concepts.

Objectives

- ♦ To offer the participants an opportunity to share and exchange their experiences and best practices.
- ♦ To make the QC movement self-generating and an ever-growing segment of Total Quality Management (TQM).
- ♦ To encourage the spirit of competition, team work and continuous improvement.

Beneficiaries

- ♦ Existing Quality Circle members.
- ♦ Individuals (employed/ self employed) who would like to learn QC concepts
- ♦ Establishments desirous of starting Quality Circles.
- ♦ Organisations striving to keep pace with changing global scenario on TQM.
- ♦ Organisations aiming for world class quality practices to be followed.

Important Points

- Participants are informed that only vegetarian food will be served in the convention.
- Knowledge test will be conducted in CCQCC 2023 for 10 marks and the same will be added to QC Case study evaluation marks.
- QC Record marks will be included in CCQCC 2022. Hence QC Record book, hard copy of case study presentation must be handed over on 09.09.2023 at the Registration Counter in the Venue.
- 10-step problem solving method will be followed in CCQCC whereas 12-step method will be followed in NCQC.
- Firms which are interested to participate NCQC-2023 based on CCQCC-2023 result Co-ordinators of the companies should send the hard and soft copies of the QC case study to HQ directly.
- Individuals (employed/ self employed) can participate as delegates after registration
- Industries can also send delegates to witness and learn with registration

Convention Events

1. Quality Circle Case Study Presentation

Case studies by QC teams from Manufacturing Industries, Service Organisations, Banks, Hospitals and IT industries will be presented in the Convention. Case studies will be presented only by the members of the QCs. Presentation will be evaluated by a panel of judges. Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to the case study presentations based on the marks scored by the teams. There is no restriction on the number of QC teams from the same organisation to participate in the case study presentations.



Teams won Silver and Gold will be recommended for participation in the National Convention to be held in December 2023 / January 2024

Submit the following in a separate cover at the Registration Counter (on 09.09.2023 forenoon)

- a) One hard copy of Case Study.
 - b) Record Book of the Quality Circle.
- ♦ Oral Presentation will be for a duration of 15 minutes followed by Q & A session for 5 minutes.
 - ♦ Computer & LCD Projector will be provided at the venue.
(To avoid compatibility issues, teams are recommended to bring their laptop)
 - ♦ Only the members of QC teams registered for the convention can present their case study.

2. Quiz

Quiz will be conducted to assess the knowledge of participants in problem solving, usage of QC tools and other QC concepts.

- Two members per team (One team per registered QC Circle).
- Open to registered QC members only.
- Preliminary rounds will be conducted on 09.09.2023 forenoon.
- Final round will be conducted on 10.09.2023 afternoon.
- Participants name , Phone Number and Mail ID should be furnished

3. Poster

Poster competitions will provide an opportunity to the QC members to exhibit their creative talent.

- Theme will be given on the spot. Only one member per registered QC Circle can participate.
- Drawing sheets, pencil and eraser will be given.
- Colouring materials to be brought by the participants.
- Event will be conducted on 09.09.2023 afternoon.

4. Slogan and Poem Competitions

The above competitions will provide an opportunity to the QC members to exhibit their creative talent.

- Theme will be given on the spot. Only one member per Registered QC Circle can participate.
- Drawing sheets, pencil and eraser will be given.
- Colouring materials to be brought by the participants
- Event will be conducted on 09.09.2023 afternoon.



5. Knowledge Test

In order to prepare the QC teams for NCQC 2023, Knowledge test (KT) has been introduced in CCQCC - 2023. It carries 10 marks and the team members have to do jointly.

6. Allied QC concepts - Six Sigma and Lean QC

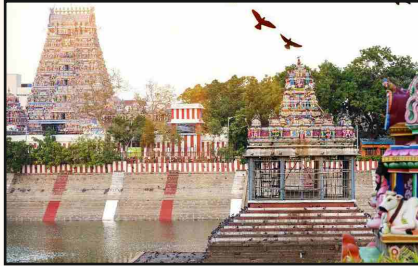
