I CASE STUDY PRESENTATION ON QUALITY CONCEPTS

TYPES OF CASE STUDIES :

Quality Circle – Lean Quality Circle – Quality Improvement teams, Six Sigma, TPM & TQM, Kaizen, Kara Kuri Kaizen, 5S and other allied Quality Concepts.

For the first time we are planning to evaluate the case studies through online. Case studies should be uploaded in the portal as per flow diagram attached for pre evaluation. Oral case study presentations will be physical. **NO NEED TO SEND HARD COPIES FOR CASE STUDY PRESENTATION FOR EVALUATION.**

- ▶ Oral Case study presentation slots can be selected by teams through Portal.
- ▶ Presentation will be held in 3 parallel streams.
- ▶ The language for the oral presentation is Tamil/English/Malayalam/Hindi (PPT must be in English for other language presentations).
- ▶ Time allotted is 15 minutes for presentation and 3 minutes for Question/Answer by Judges.
- ▶ **The participants are required to bring their own Laptop.**

GENERAL INSTRUCTION

- ▶ Only QCFI member organizations can send teams for competition.
- ▶ QC record book should be submitted at the time of registration for Quality Circles only
- ▶ Record book will be evaluated separately and the same may be collected after distribution of awards



II POSTERS - THIS YEAR THEME

1. Poster should be painted with sketch pen or brush on 45cm x 60cm white board only.
2. Language – Tamil/English/Hindi/Malayalam
3. Posters must be displayed in the areas provided for this purpose during the convention by delegates and shall be the property of the Chapter after display.
4. Maximum three entries of Posters per QC member is allowed. More entries found if any will not be considered for evaluation.

III KNOWLEDGE TEST will be conducted separately.
