Guidelines for Competitions

A) Case Study Presentations & Other Entries:

- Language will be Hindi or English
- The case studies, Poem, Poster, Slogan, Essays & Skit in soft copies have to send our Chapter email address “qcfgwaliorchapter@gmail.com” writing the subject line as **GCCQC-2024 Competition**.
- For case studies it will be considered that 70% and above will be ‘Gold’, 60% to 69% ‘Silver’ & below 60% as ‘Bronze’ Awards.
- For Poem, Poster, Slogan, Essay, one participant can send one entry for each competition. If any participant for poem, poster, slogan & essay of other than registered case study presentation, they will be considered as additional member.
- The topic for essay competitions will be the same of convention theme “**Investing in people, building a better future**” & in maximum 300 words.
- The topic for Poem, Poster & Slogan can be on any Quality Concepts such as QC, 5-S etc. The entries can be in word or in neatly hand-written format.
- The Poster should be drawn on drawing sheet. It is better to submit the scanned copy of each entry in the chapter email address mentioned above.
- The Participant name, Organization name, Team Name etc. details should be clearly mentioned at bottom of each entry.
