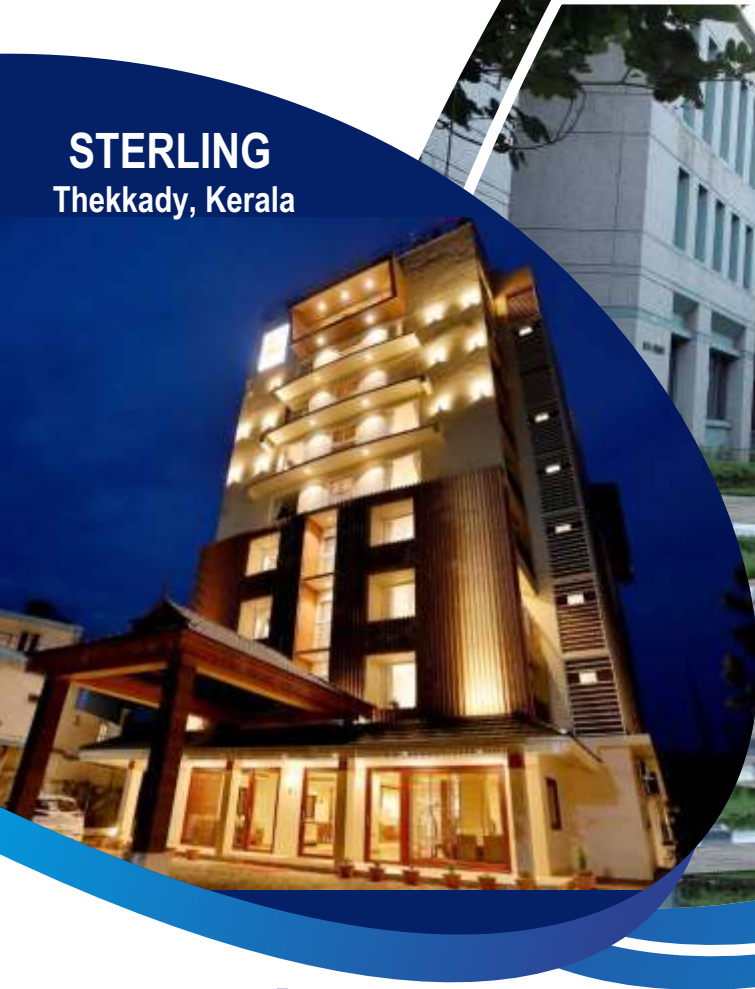

LOCATION FOR STERLING THEKKADY, KERALA

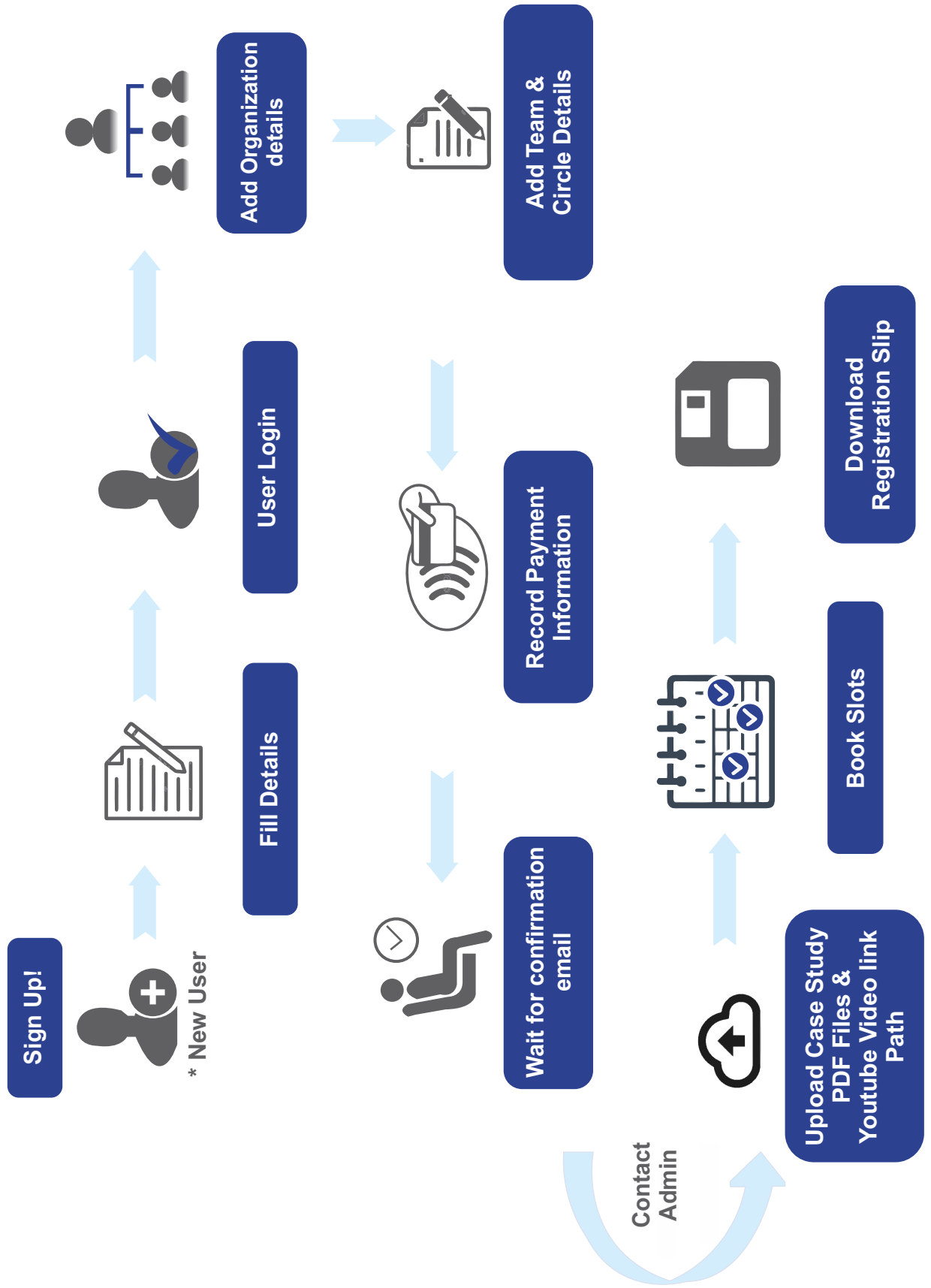
