- QCFI Coimbatore Chapter has consistently won the Best Chapter Award during all the years since inception


Program Objective

Integrated Safety Circle:

It is a combination of bottom-up approach with top supported experiential learning concepts.

Research shows that an average learner forgets 70% of what they learned within 24 hours and 90% of what they learned in a week if they don't make an effort to retain it. The percentage of information retained after classroom training depends on the teaching method used:

1. Lecture: Learners retain about 5% of the information
2. Reading: Learners retain about 10% of the information
3. Audiovisual: Learners retain about 20% of the information
4. Step-by-step demonstration: Learners retain about 30% of the information
5. Group discussion: Learners retain about 50% of the information
6. Practiced by doing: Learners retain about 75% of the information
7. Training others: Learners retain about 90% of the information
