- ◆ No need to submit hard copy of the case studies. Please send us the soft copy in .pdf or .ppt format for evaluation latest by 10th October 2025.
- ◆ For Quality Circles: Pre-evaluation+ Register+ Case study Presentation.
- ◆ For other Allied concepts: Pre-evaluation+ Case study Presentation.
- ◆ Maximum presentation is for 15 minutes in addition to 3 minutes for questions by Judges.
- ◆ The Participant name, Organization name, Team Name etc. details should be clearly mentioned in first Slide of Case study.
