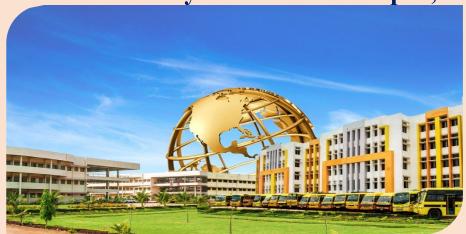

1. Case Study Presentation on Quality Concepts

A Case study will be evaluated digitally. The official language for Case study will be in Hindi or English. There would be separate evaluation criteria for each concept. Case study will be accepted for the following category:

Quality Circle	Lean Quality Circle	Kaizen	WCM Circle
Six Sigma Concepts	Integrated Safety Circle	5-8 Concept	TPM Circle

Quality Circle Forum of India has decided to upload detailed case study online in PDF format, for preevaluation latest by **1**st **October 2025** for participating at Bhilai. The size of the case study in PDF should be below 20 MB. Organizations willing to participate in INTEGRATRD SAFETY CIRCLE are requested to refer the attached guidelines, released by QCFI.

Case Study should be uploaded directly to www.qcfibhilai.in or can be mailed to ccqcbh@gmail.com in case of problem in website.

2. Case Study Oral Presentation: (Physical)

The official language for presentation will be in Hindi or English. Team should have their own power point presentation either in Hindi or English and time limit will be 15 minutes. Presentation of allied concept and Integrated Safety Circle will be conducted in separate hall and there would be separate evaluation criteria for each concept. Oral presentation of the PPT needs to be uploaded **on or before 10**th **October 2025.** (Optional)

3. Knowledge Test (KT) (Physical)

Knowledge Test for CCQC-2025 will be conducted in physical mode only. Knowledge test is compulsory for all teams. The knowledge of the participants will be evaluated based on concepts chosen by the Quality Concepts team. For this, the questions will be asked on QC, 5S, allied concepts and Integrated Safety Circle, based on the category of your participation in the convention. Duration of the test will be of 25 minutes. For Integrated Safety Circle, 4 Questions will be asked from Problem Solving Tools & Techniques (PSTT) and 16 questions from General safety. Reading material for Integrated Safety Circle can be downloaded from websites Similarly reading manuals for other concepts can be purchased from QCFI. Only Facilitator of Integrated Safety Circle is allowed to participate in KT & Presentation.

Questions will be of multiple-choice question (MCQ) type. Question banks can be downloaded from website after your registration is completed for ISC. In Knowledge test for Quality Circle and Integrated Safety Circle, minimum three persons should attempt and average marks will be considered for evaluation. For other allied concepts, minimum two persons can attempt for Knowledge test and average of two will be considered.



4. Essay/Poem/Slogan Competition

To encourage the creativity among the members, various competitions are being organized like Essay, Slogan and Poem. An essay competition will be conducted on the theme of the convention CCQC-2025. The essay should be with-in 500 words. Interested QC members shall mail their entries in Hindi or in English (with your name and address) at ccqcbh@gmail.com; latest by 4th October, 2025. Winners will be given certificate, and a memento to those who attend the convention during inaugural function. Result will be declared by 8th October 2025 and winners will also be informed through email/ SMS.

Exclusive services offered by QCFI, Bhilai Chapter for CCQC-2025 are:

- 1. Conducting CCQC-2025 in highly professional manner so that teams recommended from Bhilai Chapter may able to get Par Excellence/Excellence Award during NCQC-2025.
- 2. Improvement is a continual journey and the Analysis of Chapter revealed that performance of many QC teams affects due to poor scoring in Knowledge Test (KT). Keeping this in mind, Bhilai Chapter has introduced that as soon as you register for convention, you will be eligible to down load the question bank. All the question will be asked from the question bank only.
- 3. Judges Feedback on Case Study along with suggestion for further improvement is also an innovative feature.

Final Program at a Glance:

- a) Each Team should submit their case study online only. No Hard Copy will be entertained.
- b) Knowledge Test will be conducted in Physical Mode only.
- c) Oral Case Study Presentation will be conducted in Physical mode only.
- d) Case Study Feedback will be provided on-line only along with contact person's name for further clarifications.
- e) Award will be given as per criteria given below:
 - i. The Circles who score less than 60% will be awarded Bronze Medal
 - ii. The Circles who score between 60% and 70% will be awarded Silver Medal
 - iii. The Circles who score 70% and above marks will be awarded Gold Medal

Only Gold/Selected Silver winning teams will be recommended for participating during NCQC-2025 to be held at New Delhi from 19th to 22nd December 2025.

Other than being home to the world-famous Bhilai Steel Plant, the region is packed with places of worship, historical landmarks, and scenic vistas that draw visitors from all around.

In addition to being one of Bhilai's most popular places to shop, Civic Center is also home to a variety of exciting attractions, including a thrilling amusement park.



Thagada Dam, Durg

An island has been prepared in the middle of the dam amidst attractive lighting. A boating facility and 16 shops and seating arrangements for eating and drinking are also above the Chowpatty with colorful fountain inside dam enchanting its beauty.



Maitri Bagh adjacent to Bhilai, with a zoo, boating, dancing fountain and park designed for visitors alike spread in 111 acres. Historical records reveal that Russia and India signed the peace treaty that led to the creation of the Maitri Bagh.



Dongargarh is 75 kilometers from Bhilai via Durg and Rajnandgaon. Bambleshwari Temple is at Dongargarh in Rajnandgaon district, Chhattisgarh, India. It is on a hilltop of 1600 feet. This temple is referred as Badi Bambleshwari.
