The program will address the following concern areas :-

- To improve grass root employees' knowledge on occupational safety.
- To improve observation power.
- To differentiate between Hazards and Risks.
- To understand five human factors which are responsible for 90% of accidents.
- To understand near misses and the importance of reporting.
- Improve analytical power.
- To have a better documentation system.
- To improve teamwork. This is the most important factor which has been "MAGIC" in case of "Lean Safety Circle" and brings in sustained improvement culture.

Program for Whom?

The program is meant for all supervisory staff including safety staff who are keen on bringing the improvement in occupational safety in their work area, be it a workshop or construction site, or a process plant.

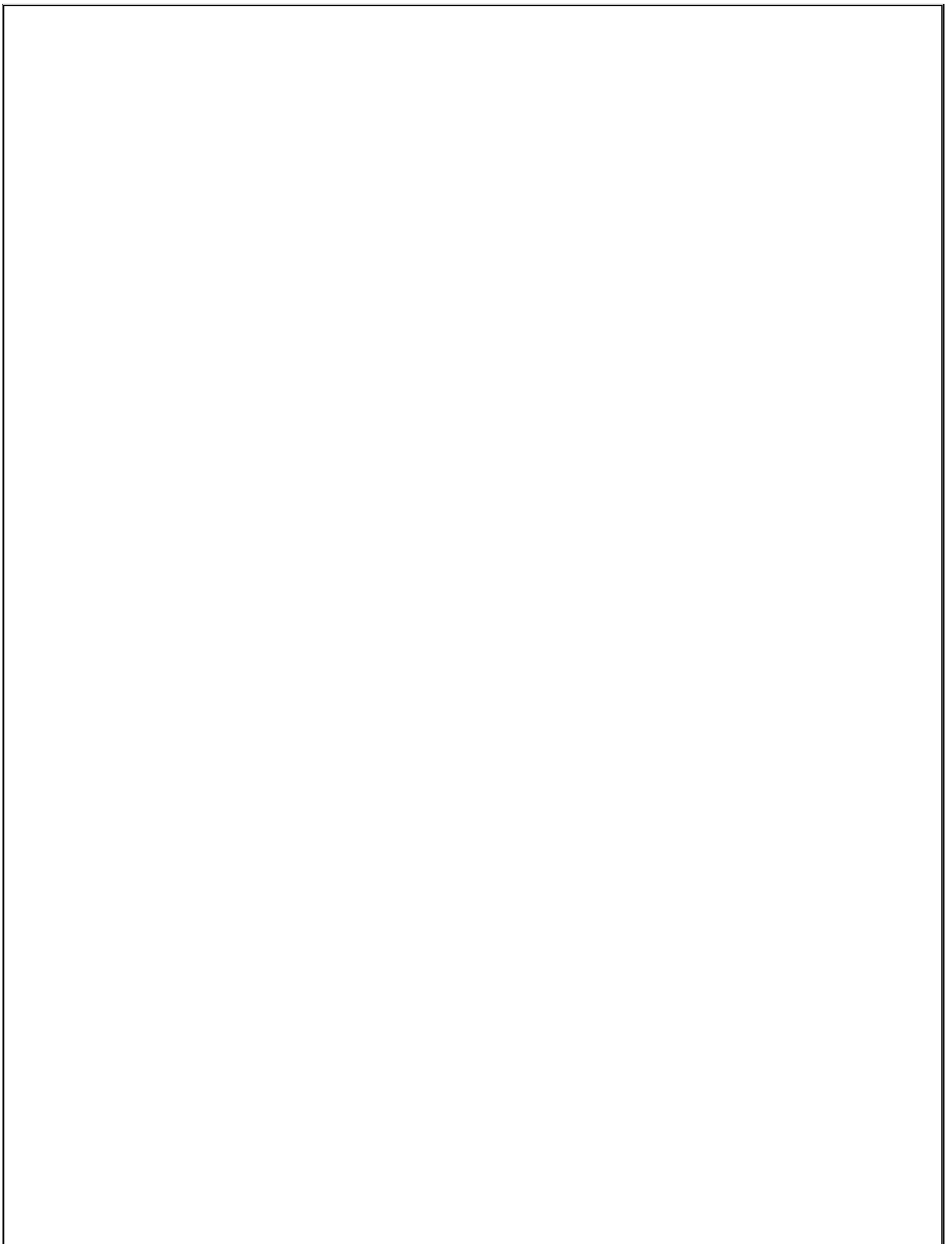
