VALUE ADDED ATTRACTIONS IN THE CONVENTION

KNOWLEDGE TEST (Optional): A test for each team, irrespective of the stream, about the philosophy of quality concepts and basic knowledge about QC tools & techniques of problem-solving approaches which includes QC, LQC, LSC, Allied concepts.

Duration: 20 min / 20 Questions

The test will be conducted online.

Facilitators are permitted along with Members.

ESSAY :

Theme: “Leading With Quality For Sustainable Growth And Self Reliance”

Eligibility: Only team members participating in the convention are eligible & one Essay in any one language per person is allowed.

Language (any one): Kannada, Hindi or English.

Word Limit: Not more than 400 words.

Medium: Handwritten, Legible on an A4 Size paper with 2 cm margins on all sides.

Note: Please mention your Participating Team Name and Organization Name. Essay should be sent to office for pre evaluation.

SLOGAN & POSTER :

Theme: “Leading With Quality For Sustainable Growth And Self Reliance”

Eligibility: Only team members participating in the Convention are eligible & one Slogan/Poster in any one language per person is allowed.

Language (any one): Kannada, Hindi or English.

Medium: Handwritten, Legible on an A3 Size paper with 3 cm margins on all sides.

Note: Please mention your Participating Team Name and Organization Name. Slogan and poster should be sent to office for pre evaluation.

Last Date for submission: 25th August 2026.

DISPLAY OF KAIZENS:

The main objective is to bring out the creative talent of the individuals.

- Only two members shall participate in display of Kaizen & in case of 2 Kaizen, 2 teams of 2 members each shall present their Kaizen.
- It can be explained in Model or in the Poster of A-3 size format given by QCFI in Form No.3.
- Each team shall send the copies of 1 Kaizen in A-4 format for pre-evaluation (50marks).
- Kaizen display shall be assessed for 50 marks by the panel of Juries visiting the spot.
- Maximum time allowed for presentation / explanation is 10 minutes only. Kaizen shall be awarded as per the same criteria.

MODEL DEMONSTRATION/DISPLAY:

- 2 members shall participate in a team to demonstrate the Model display and explain to the Judges during their evaluation visit. The awards will be as per the criteria given below.

PRODUCT EXHIBITION:

- Convention is an opportunity for technocrats, end users, and participants, to interact and get to know the latest developments in the Manufacturing and Service sectors.
- The Exhibition covers all fields like Manufacturing, Steel, Cement, Textiles, Fertilizers, Power Engineering, Confectionery, Mechanical, Electrical, Electronics, Instrumentation, Garment industries, Food & Beverage Products, and Service sector.
- The Exhibitors are provided (3m x 3m) space at the venue with a provision of display table, illumination facility and infrastructure.
- Stall allotment shall be strictly done on first cum first basis. QCFI solicits wide response from various sectors of industry, including service sectors, to utilize the opportunity at CCQC 2026.
- Delegates are requested to drop their business cards in the drop box provided in each stall.

KAIZEN and 5S CONCEPT BY HOME MAKERS

- In order to encourage Kaizen / 5S practices at home, QCFI wishes to encourage / recognize home makers at CCQC 2026, who have done improvements in their homes, to exhibit through Model or Poster or PPT. PARTICIPATION IS FREE. Best teams shall be awarded. Participating teams shall have to register their names by sending a mail to QCFI on or before 25th August 2026.
- Only participating Organizations can send 1 Home Kaizen only.
- Only first 10 Home Kaizen shall be considered on the “First Come First Serve Basis”.

RECOGNITION

Based on the evaluation by a panel of judges, the participating teams shall be awarded with certificate:

- **QC Record Book (QC Teams only) to be submitted at the registration counter on the day of Convention.**

RULES FOR PARTICIPATION IN CONVENTION

- Only Institutional members of QCFI only are eligible to participate in Presentation/Display.
- Non-members of QCFI can also participate by enrolling as member immediately by submitting Membership Application form obtainable from Head Quarters Website www.qcfi.in.
- Teams from outside Region/Chapter can also participate. Any number of teams can be nominated.
- All QC teams have to **mandatorily submit their QC Record Book for evaluation**. Marks obtained from QC Record Book shall be considered for awards in CCQC 2026. QC Record Book to be **submitted** by the teams at the registration counter (for evaluation) on the convention day **before 9.00 AM** and obtain the receipt of acknowledgement. And **collect back** the Record Book at the trophy distribution counter on the same day **after 02.00 PM** by returning **the receipt of acknowledgement**. If the QC record is not taken back after valedictory, the teams shall be responsible to collect the same from QCFI Bengaluru Office after the convention at the earliest.
- **Maximum 15 minutes** are allowed for presentation / display.
- **The case studies should pertain to the period June 2025- May 2026**. The case studies already presented at Regional/Chapter/National Convention shall be disqualified.
- **Front page of case study** should have the following details:
 - o Name of Organization
 - o Name of team
 - o Title of Case Study
 - o Category (viz. QC, Allied, Kaizen, 5-S, Six-sigma etc.)
 - o Name of the Team Members
- The case study should be submitted as softcopies (use MS Office 2007).
- **Non-members (Institutional / Individual)** can participate as **DELEGATES** only.
- **The last date for registration is 25th August 2026**.
- However, spot registration is allowed only for Delegates by making the payment suitably at the registration counter at convention.
- Registration fee can be paid by Cheque/DD drawn in favour of **QUALITY CIRCLE FORUM OF INDIA, BENGALURU CHAPTER**, payable at Bengaluru/ through the online payment shown in the portal.
